From the Pastor's Desk

My Dear People:

The New Book I have written on the Holy Sacrifice and how the people participate in the priesthood of offering Christ to the Father is printed with an Imprimatur. I wrote the book because I cannot find anything that stresses the main message of the book and really felt the Lord calling me to write it. The only book that really stresses the point was printed in 1951. Popes and the famous Catechism of the Catholic Church amplify it, but catechisms seem to stress the Sacred Banquet, rather than the sacrificial aspect of the Mass.

The cover of the book is the celebrated picture of Christ on the cross offered to the Father. It is a masterpiece of art, which has appeared on EWTN, and I have noticed a large copy of the picture in the vestibule of Our Lady of the Valley Church. It features God the Father reaching down to accept the offering of His Son on the cross for the salvation of the world. The incredible bright light behind the scene reminds us that this is the greatest moment in the history of the world; for this is the hour of reconciliation between God and the human race.

I would like you to consider two things: 1) If you will read at least part of the book, please pick up a copy from the vestibule and know that it is yours; and 2) If you know a non-Catholic who has asked why Catholics go to Mass and are so intent and devout in Church, offer a copy of the book to them.

Since I have written several publishers, begging for a hearing that they might consider publishing the book, I have received only one answer, and they claimed that they are two years behind and recommended a sister publishing company. If there are any royalties, they will go to the Catholic Center of Concern. The book is simply written, no

heavy theological jargon, with an economy of words and large print. It is gaged to non-Catholics and to those who would like to appreciate the Holy Sacrifice more.

Please pray that a publisher will pick it up, print, advertise and circulate this book for many others to read. I do believe in the power of prayer, especially those of our own OLS people.

Father Frankline will celebrate 15 years of priesthood at the 11:30 a.m. Mass this Sunday, with a reception afterwards. So many thanks to Fr. Frankline for his service and continued service to OLS.

Four High School graduates from OLS have served as altar servers as seniors in High School. Jacob Gagnon, Franz Mercado, Jacob Pugh, and Christopher Shields are examples to the younger servers to keep on serving through high school. We also honor these servers with certificates and with their names on a plaque in the sacristy.

Serving Mass is such an honor and a privilege, and the captain of these "soldiers of the altar" is Mr. Kent Graeve. He trains and schedules them, praises and encourages them. A million thanks to Mr. Graeve, since we need these noble servers at the altar.
